- Artwork produced within the last 2 years
- Any media accepted
- No signed, printed reproductions
- Must be ready to hang or stand securely
- Artwork no larger than 40" wide and 54" high
- Artwork weight no more than 100 pounds
- Artwork should not have been exhibited in previous Members and Friends shows
- The Art Center reserves the right to refuse artwork that does not meet these requirements or is found unsuitable for exhibiting.
- The Art Center cannot be held responsible for artwork left more than 45 days from the last day of pick-up.

2010 SHOW JUROR William Butler

After graduating from Northern Illinois University in 1986, William worked for about eight years as a graphic designer and illustrator, much of the time for a toy company near Aurora, Illinois. From 1994-1999, Williams showed his Wyeth-like watercolors in galleries and at numerous art fairs throughout the Midwest, east coast and Florida, winning many awards. His watercolors are included in Western and Eastern Illinois University collections.

From 1995-2002, he created hand-painted linoleum relief prints. His pop art inspired coffee addiction series was very popular in galleries and art fairs. The wood block look influences his current work. Inspired out of a love of comic books and pop art, his current work features boldly colored and bulbous forms that seem to be inconstant motion. These objects almost look familiar, but are altered and combined with other imagery that may surprise or baffle the viewer.

He has recently shown work in group exhibits in Chicago, Toronto, Monmouth and Galex 44 at the Galesburg Civic Art Center. He will exhibit at Illinois Central College this fall in a 2-person exhibit with Doug Goessman.

William resides in Peoria and is in his 7th year as Executive Directors of the Contemporary Art Center of Peoria. William is the only full-time staff so he wears many hats as well as being curator of exhibits. Besides judging numerous local exhibits, he has served as a juror/judge for the St. Louis Artist Guild Member Exhibition, St. Louis, Missouri in 2006 and as juror/judge for the Mosaics Festival for the Arts, St. Charles, Missouri in 2009.
